

Community Challenge Matching Grant Details

Eligibility:

Interested local, volunteer-run organizations must be a registered 501c3 nonprofit in good standing with the IRS with public charity designation 509(a)1 or 509 (a)2 and must submit a recent Form 990, 990 EZ or 990 N, list of Board of Directors, and Current Year Operating Budget

Requirements:

Grant recipients agree to send at least one email and/or mailed letter notifying constituents of the Blue Foundry Community Challenge Matching Grant. The communication will include the provided flyer and Blue Foundry Charitable Foundation link(s).

FAQs:

How long is the Matching Grant period?

Once applicants have been notified by the Blue Foundry Charitable Foundation of acceptance into the Community Challenge Matching Grant program, the non-profit organizations will have 4 weeks to send emails to constituents and collect donations.

What donations will be matched by Blue Foundry Charitable Foundation?

Paid donations from individuals, received during the designated fundraising window will be matched up to the amount of \$2,500.

What donations will not be matched?

Corporate donations

Pledged (unpaid) donations

In-kind (material) donations

Any part of a donation which paid for goods or services

Other grants

How will the organization report its fundraising results?

The organization will submit donation receipts in the form of a bank statement listing individual deposits from donations, Venmo Statement or other agreed upon documentation
